

Tips for exporting your design from



1. With your design opened, click the "Share" button located in the top right corner of the web page.
2. Click on "Download" in the pop-up menu, and change the following settings:
 - Select "PDF Print" as the file type
 - Enable "Crop marks and bleeds"
 - Check "Flatten PDF"
 - Set the color profile to "RGB (best for digital use)"
3. Click the "Download" button
